

ACA Austria Course Equivalencies at WWU

This guide identifies how courses taken at Bogenhofen Adventist College through Adventist Colleges Abroad (ACA) will apply toward requirements for general studies and for a minor in German at Walla Walla University.

Please note: One ACA course may apply toward both a general studies requirement and the electives requirement for a minor in German. Any ACA course not applicable toward either general studies or the electives requirement for a minor in German will count as general elective credit.

Any GRMN-prefix course at the intermediate level or higher (course numbers 200 and above) may apply as elective credit toward a minor in German at WWU.
