

ACA Brazil Course Equivalencies at WWU

This guide identifies how courses taken at Faculdade Adventista da Bahia through Adventist Colleges Abroad (ACA) will apply toward requirements for general studies and for a minor in Portuguese at Walla Walla University.

Please note: One ACA course may apply toward both a general studies requirement and the electives requirement for a minor in Portuguese. Any ACA course not applicable toward either general studies or the electives requirement for a minor in Portuguese will count as general elective credit.

* Please note: A Portuguese language course satisfying the Engaging Society requirement may not also apply toward the Language requirement for BA students.

Minor in Portuguese

Any PORT-prefix course at the intermediate level or higher (course numbers 200 and above) may apply as elective credit toward a minor in Portuguese at WWU.
