

# ACA Italy Course Equivalencies at WWU

This guide identifies how courses taken at Italian Adventist College Villa Aurora through Adventist Colleges Abroad (ACA) will apply toward requirements for general studies and for a minor in Italian at Walla Walla University.

Please note: One ACA course may apply toward both a general studies requirement and the electives requirement for a minor in Italian. Any ACA course not applicable toward either general studies or the electives requirement for a minor in Italian will count as general elective credit.
