

# ACA Spain Course Equivalencies at WWU

This guide identifies how courses taken at Campus Adventista de Sagunto through Adventist Colleges Abroad (ACA) will apply toward requirements for general studies and for a minor in Spanish at Walla Walla University.

Please note: One ACA course may apply toward both a general studies requirement and the electives requirement for a minor in Spanish. Any ACA course not applying toward either general studies or the electives requirement for a minor in Spanish will count as general elective credit.
