

Pre-Professional Programs

Programs are offered in a wide variety of fields to prepare students for admission to professional schools or to enter technical careers. Students wishing to secure admission to such schools should familiarize themselves with the admission requirements of the school of their choice. Most pre-professional curriculums require two units of high school mathematics (algebra and geometry). All programs should be planned in consultation with and approved by the assigned academic adviser. The following pre-professional curricula are detailed in the Pre-professional Programs section.
