General Areas of Service: A wide variety of job opportunities exist for a person with an associate degree, including bookkeeping, purchasing, inventory management, billing, sales, other clerical and office work, and small business management. Some students complete an associate degree as a seamless step toward a bachelor's degree, with the intent of having better work opportunities during their junior and senior years.

Job Outlook: Demand for those with associate degrees comes mainly from business support services. Demand for these services is projected to be above average over the next decade. (See www.bls.gov)

Earnings: The projected earnings with an associate degree vary widely, depending on the industry and location of the job. The lifetime earnings of those with an associate degree are considerably higher than those with only a high school diploma. (See www.bls.gov)
