

## Associate of Science in Business 2025-2026

**General Areas of Service:** A wide variety of job opportunities exist for a person with an associate degree, including bookkeeping, purchasing, inventory management, billing, sales, other clerical and office work, and small business management. Some students complete an associate degree as a seamless step toward a bachelor's degree, with the intent of having better work opportunities during their junior and senior years.

**Job Outlook:** Demand for those with associate degrees comes mainly from business support services. Demand for these services is projected to be above average over the next decade. (See [www.bls.gov](http://www.bls.gov))
