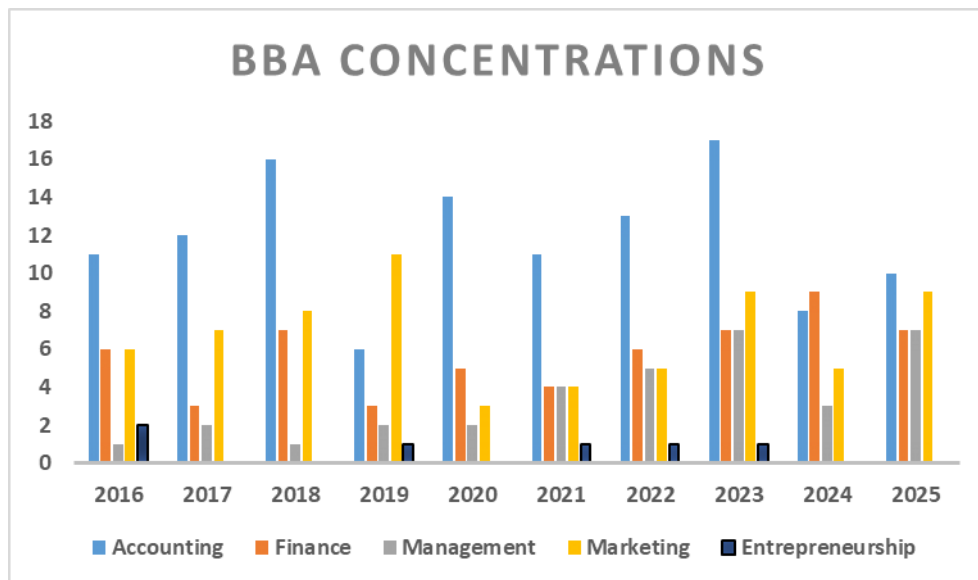


**Degrees accredited by the Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP):*

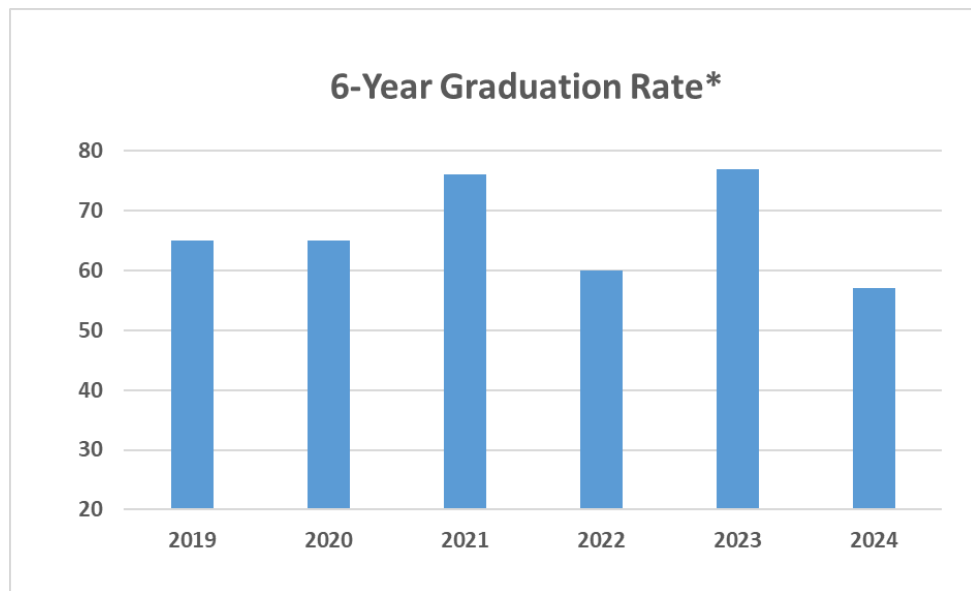

Degrees NOT accredited by ACBSP:

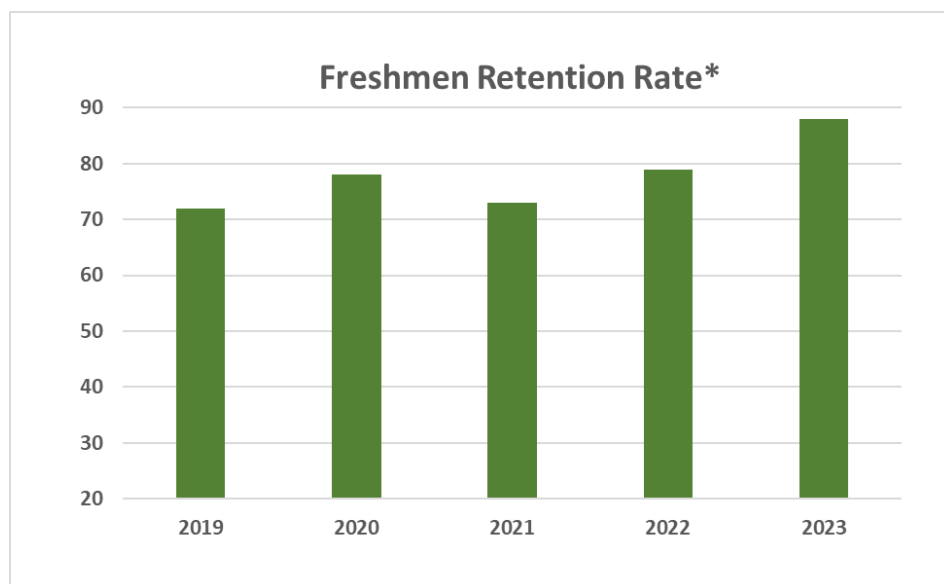
